

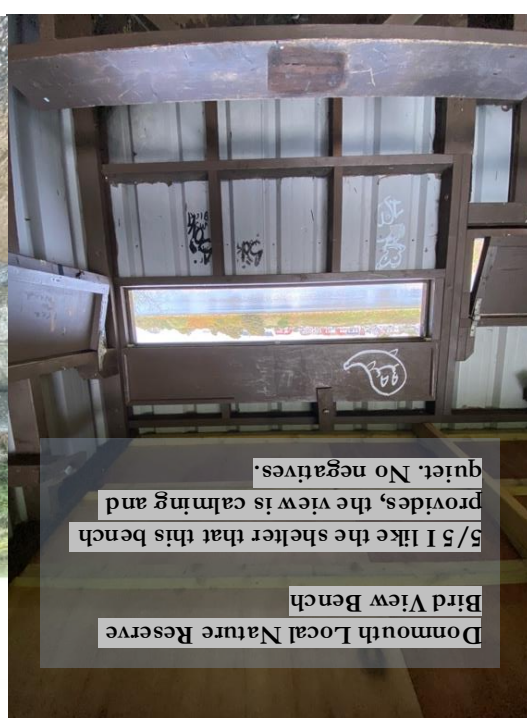

Aberdeen Beach



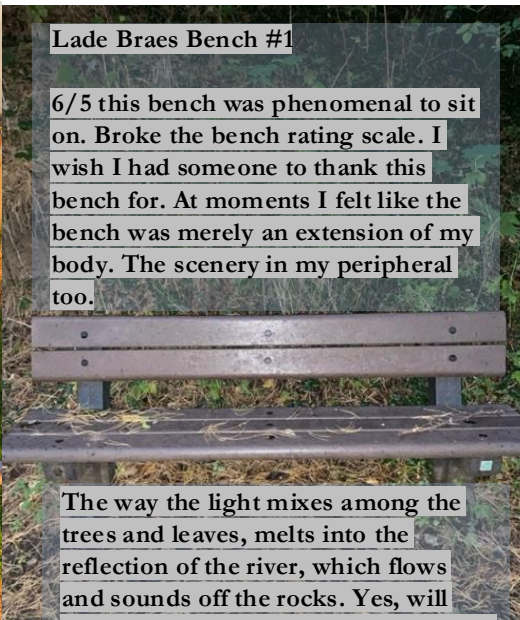
Donmouth Local Nature Reserve

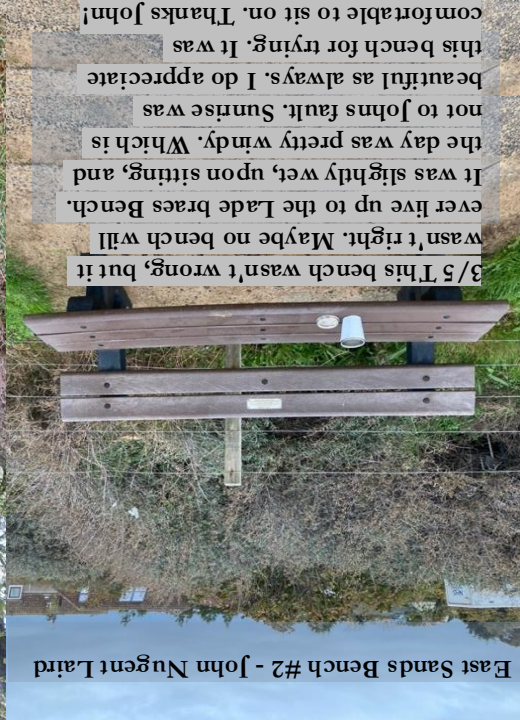


Bench on Grangehill
